

ADHAR'S SECOND INNINGS

Senior Parents' Home - Nashik

ADHAR started operating its first lifelong care unit for Intellectually Challenged Adults at Badlapur, 27 years back and currently takes care of 340 such specially abled children at Badlapur & Nashik (which was started 9 years back). Adhar has been a role model for such type of lifetime care residential institutes across India and is duly recognized by Government as well as other eminent organizations.

The fundamental concept behind Adhar was to provide a lifetime relief to parents of such Special Children by addressing their basic need of "Who will look after my special child after me?"

In last 27 years, Adhar has provided relief to more than 1000 parents of Special Children by providing comprehensive and holistic lifetime care to the specially abled and is continuing its work relentlessly. In this period of 27 years, the young children have grown old and are now about 50 + years of age. Their parents also in the meantime have grown older and would be around 70-75 + years old. They would have retired from their jobs and their means of income would be limited. They would be facing challenges to their health due to old age. Parents who have a single child and that too a specially abled one do not have any other support mechanism to take care of themselves in the twilight years of their lives. Parents who have faced immense hardships and challenges while bringing up their specially abled child now face an existential challenge while taking care of themselves. This poses a unique challenge to the institution and hence Adhar has come up with a Visionary Concept of starting a Senior Parents' Home for such aging parents.

By doing so, Adhar has taken its cause to a next level wherein it not only provides relief of the parents by taking lifelong care of the specially abled children, but also plans to take care of the parents through an institutionalised old age care facility for the parents. This is going to have a major positive impact on the lives of these dependent parents by providing a

Adhar has put in a lot of careful thought and planning while designing the new Senior Parents Home at Nashik and is striving hard to provide comprehensive care services with an excellent infrastructure. Minute details regarding comfort, entertainment and providing a fulfilling life have been taken care of.

We intend to provide the below facilities at 'Home of senior Parents of specially abled children' –

- There will be 20 rooms in the complex (Twin Sharing Basis).
- It is located near Nashik city which provides good access to all daily necessities.
- Basic facilities like hygienic food, laundry, self-sufficient residential facility, telephone & internet access, CCTV Security, recreational facilities like TV & Music, Newspapers, Garden, etc. have been provided
- Care for their physical health with proper medical facilities.
- To help them keep engaged and prevent loneliness, depression is made possible with the support of active & caring staff who will engage them in various activities like picnics, library, and also organize motivational talks on different topics, meditation, yoga classes etc.

In addition to the above facilities, we will also

- Support them to complete their personal chores like buying their essential things, banking etc. and also by providing transportation to nearest city of Nashik for personal work.
- Any other need-based requirement on case-to-case basis will be provided to make living comfortable.

Who can benefit from this Senior Parents Home at Nashik?

- Parents of specially abled children residing at Adhar First Preference
- 2. Parents of specially abled children who may not be residing at Adhar **Second Preference**
- 3. Senior Parents of General Category not necessarily having a special child **10% of capacity**

New Cattle Shed at Badlapur

ADHAR, Badlapur has been having inhouse cattle shed for the past 16 years and it has immensely helped in providing captive milk supply to our residents. The benefit is not only in terms of cost but also in terms of quality of milk given to the residents. Additionally, it gives important byproducts like Curd, Butter Milk, Ghee, etc. which is of very good quality. This ensures that our special ones get purest milk and milk products for consumption all the time. On an average, the cattle shed supplies 60 Liters of milk per day and thus fulfills almost 80% of our requirements on an annual basis. We also get some additional revenue from sale of the new born male buffalos & calves to other farmers in surrounding villages.

The existing cattle shed was built 16-17 years back and has limited capacity in terms of providing shelter to the cattle. Over the years, its structure started requiring frequent maintenance and refurbishments adding to Adhar's expenses every year since the past 2 years. Hence, it was felt that a New Cattle Shed needs to be constructed which would be of larger area to accommodate more cattle and also provide better facilities to them & the care takers of the shed.

A well wisher and donor agreed to fund for the construction of New Cattle Shed by donating the required amount and



thus we have now a New Shed constructed and made operational. It was inaugurated on 30th July 2021 at the hands of our Senior Trustees & Vice Chairman Mr. Talwar & Mrs. Talwar along with Trustee Mrs. Saraswathy.

One more advantage of building these new cattle shed is the space created by clearing of the old shed which can now can be developed into a garden with walking track & sitting area which will be enjoyed by our residents soon in future.



Material Donation from DonateKart

ADHAR recently engaged with a crowd funding platform called 'DonateKart' which helps NGOs and other social organization to raise daily consumption material through donation by crowd funding. DonateKart was greatly impressed with Adhar's work in the area of providing Lifetime Care of Intellectually Challenged Adults.

This crowd funding organization helped us to create a campaign by sending a professional cameraman to create a very touching and realistic video about how we take care of our special ones and how people can help us by donating material required for our daily consumption like grocery,

hygiene & sanitary material. Antiseptics & disinfectants, bathroom & floor cleaners, handwash & soaps, toothpaste & mosquito repellents, etc. These were also donated by the general public through their web portal. They also helped us get bedsheets, pillow covers, towels and Solapuri Chaddars through this campaign. Adhar could raise donation of the above items worth 50 Lakhs+ through this campaign and it has been a great support towards bridging our deficit gap in operating expenses.

This has been a great learning experience and we will continue to explore this option in future.

Solar Power Plant at Badlapur

ADHAR's Badlapur unit needs a huge amount of electricity for its 4 dormitories, 1 special care unit, administration office, vocational workshop, water pumps, laundry unit and for campus lighting. The monthly electricity charges incurred per month amount to more than 1 lakh and is one of the major constituents of Adhar's monthly expenditure cost. Additionally, due to frequent electricity outages from MSEDCL, our diesel-based generator runs for many hours in a day thus adding to fuel and maintenance cost.

We have been planning to commission a Solar Powered Electricity Generation Plant for quite some time but due to high capital cost, the project could not take off in the past. We tried alternative means like wind energy but it was not efficient as well as sufficient for our need. We could only use solar power for heating water in the dormitory bathrooms effectively and hence there was limited impact on cost savings.

We recently approached H. T. Parekh Foundation (which is our regular donor for last 2-3 years) through our trustee Mr. Ajay Mehta and requested to consider supporting a proposal for a Solar Power Plant which would be sufficient for the entire Adhar, Badlapur campus.

They were very considerate and agreed to sponsor a 40 kW Solar Power Plant for Adhar, Badlapur. H. T. Parekh Foundation has tied up with Centre for Environmental Research & Education (C.E.R.E.) as an implementation partner for helping NGOs to use renewable & environmentally friendly energy sources for fulfilling their electricity needs. CERE specializes in implementing various projects in the

areas of Solar Power, Urban Afforestation, Carbon Mapping, Rainwater Harvesting & Biodiversity Gardens in both urban and rural areas.

For implementing Solar Power Plants, CERE has tied up with Avesta Solar, an organization specializing in installation & commissioning of Solar Power Plants in India using the latest Swiss & German Inverter Technology which gives maximum efficiency, long life, and trouble-free operation.

We had to construct a separate room behind our existing multi-

purpose hall for installing the Solar Panels and for housing the batteries & inverters required for this plant. A well-wisher & donor helped us by donating the required amount for the same. The 40 KW plant has 2 sets of Panels – one installed on the newly made battery room and other on Dormitory No.4. This Solar Power Plant can generate sufficient power to meet the entire electricity requirement of Adhar, Badlapur campus in case of stoppage of supply from MSEDCL. The batteries get charged regularly from the power generated from panels. The set-up includes a state- of- the- art control and automatic switchover system. The commissioned plant is currently undergoing various tests and tweaking of settings to get

However, rest of the residents those who are severely retarded were still restricted in the Dormitories only. Hence, psychologist Mrs. Rupal Ajmera come up with the concept of Toy Library where all Social workers can utilise the toys among their dormitory to make their residents busy in some activity.

Social workers and Workshop Teachers are coordinating well

to make the residents busy and keep them occupied. We are planning to expand this library for the overall development of severally challenged children.

Sewage Treatment Plant at Nashik

Adhar Nashik is situated at a very beautiful location overseeing 'Kadva' Dam and Sahyadri mountain ranges in view. The location has pleasant climate throughout the year and our special ones at Nashik enjoy these surroundings through exertions & outings many times.

However, the land on which the Nashik unit is built is made of hard rocks and it is at an slightly elevated level than the surrounding area. All our attempts to dig bore wells for ensuring constant water Sewage Water Recycling Plant at Adhar, Nashik with the help of an expert organization. M/s. Ultratech Water Recycling Solutions, has more than 35 years of experience in this field and they have done many projects which are successful in achieving up to 75% of water recycling. They were also found to be very cost effective in terms of capital expenditure and operating expenses.

The installation & commissioning of this Sewage Treatment Plant at Adhar,



Nashik was completed in July 2021 and the plant is under testing currently.

We plan to recycle sewage water from bathrooms & dormitories as well as from the laundry unit which can then be re-used for cleaning of common areas of dormitories and also for our gardening purpose. This will considerably reduce the fresh water requirement of the unit and will also help to develop & maintain green and clean surroundings throughout the year.



supply have not yielded any positive results. Adhar Nashik has to depend on 2 sources of water outside Adhar for its daily requirement of almost 40,000 liters of water. During the summer months of April-to-June, these external water sources also dry up and many times we have to depend on water tankers.

Water is a very precious natural resource and every opportunity to conserve water is like generating new water and Adhar Nashik uses this resource very judiciously. However, the requirement of water to maintain hygiene & cleanliness of our special ones is large and hence we were planning to use means to at least conserve & recycle water efficiently.

After survey of various options and alternatives, we decided to install a


