- Q. Which State do you belong to?
- A. Uttar Pradesh
- Q. Why do you come to far away Mumbaileaving Your own Village?
- **A.** We don't get job in U.P even if we get we are poorly paid.
- Q. How many cows and buffaloes are there now in Adhar Cowshed?
- A. Buffalos? and 5 Cows
- Q. How many calves are there?
- A. 2 cow calves and 4 buffalo calves.
- Q. What thing do you feed the animals?
- A. Chuni, Khari, Chowka, Pinda and dry grass we give them morning and

evening. In rainy season green grass, is given.

- Q. If they fall sick what will you do?
- **A.** We call animal doctor and give medicine to them.
- Q. What is the difference between old and new Cowshed?
- **A.** We like new Cowshed but there are many potholes on the floor which is difficult to clean.
- Q. How many times do you milk the animals?
- A. Morning and Evening
- Q. How many litres of milk do we get from them?
- A. 70 litres of milk.
- Q. What do you do with the milk?
- A. We give it to Adhar.
- Q. How do you find Adhar?
- A. Adhar is great. We like to work here.

Q. Who are there in your family in U.P and what work they do there?

- **A.** Kanta bhaiya said, "in my family my mother, my wife, sons are there. they work in field."
- Q. What do you do with the Cowdung?
- **A.** Make fertiliser with the Cowdung. We also burn the dry cowdung to drive away mosquitoes.
- Q. Kanta Bhaiya, for how many years you work in Adhar?
- A. For the last 16 years.
- Q. What about your food?
- **A.** Breakfast, lunch and dinner tea etc we get from Adhar daily.

While leaving Rita asked kanta bhaiya hum tumhare guests hai chai nahi pilayenge. All started laughing. Students enjoyed the VISIT.
