It was a glorious event with quite a large audience. Many were apprehensive of the turnout as it was on 30th March the auspicious day of Ram Navmi and there were multiple religious get togethers organised. It was hence a pleasant surprise and a delight that so many people turned up at the ceremony. This also means that Adhar is moving swiftly towards its goal of providing lifelong care to at least 1000 children thereby benefiting a 1000 families. The Satara campus will provide lifelong care for about 150 specially abled adults. This will take the total number of children under the Adhar umbrella to about 600. The entire construction cost of the campus has been borne by our generous

donors - the ADIT Foundation, Mauritius, and ADNA Foundation, Pune. This ensures that there is no burden on the financials of the parents. More details about the project are enclosed inside the issue.

We continue to work on providing holistic and high quality lifelong care for the specially abled and being mindful of the fact that we cannot put too much burden on the parents and siblings. We are continuously engaging with donors across the spectrum – corporates, rotary clubs, individuals, families, etc. Their support is vital for our success.

One such successful platforms for engaging parents and corporates in the cause of Adhar is the tata Mumbai Marathon. Adhar got associated with TMM in the year 2019 and every year is another step in going up the ladder in TMM. This issue also covers our continuing success with respect to our participation in the Tata Mumbai Marathon. In fact, this year, Adhar has been awarded the Tata Citation of Achievement for being the highest fundraising NGO in the Disability cause category at the Tata Mumbai Marathon 2023! This is a very proud achievement as we have achieved this distinction within a short time of 4 years. The TMM team has worked very had on this and has achieved spectacular success. The team has been ably led by Mr. Ajay Mehta and we hope for greater participation from parents and well wishers to see that we grow this avenue in the future.

This quarter also marked the inauguration of 3 important projects:

Adhar continues its successful participation @ Tata Mumbai Marathon

The Tata Mumbai Marathon is an annual international marathon held on the third Sunday of January in Mumbai, India. Over the years, the fundraising platform has gained prominence as the largest sporting platform for philanthropy in India. The Tata Mumbai Marathon provides a platform for many NGOs like Adhar to raise funds. It not only helps in fundraising but is also a good platform to get good visibility. Adhar was happy to participate in the Tata Mumbai Marathon this year after a gap of 2 years of COVID.

It was a grand event with a good number of participants from Adhar. We also had a stall in the motivation zone. This event again proved that Mumbai has a very big heart. Adhar was able to raise around ₹ 58 lakhs from this years event. This fundraising was possible due to consistent help from corporates like Pamac, Teamspace, HDFC Ergo, Zeel Infotech, Incorp, MCA & MTS.

The NGO privilege levels help the



participating NGOs to plan their fundraising campaign at the Tata Mumbai Marathon in an effective and structured manner. These indicators, once achieved, are converted into points. Moreover, the points accumulated are converted into additional privileges for the respective NGO.

Adhar has reached the Diamond level in TMM 2023. this year, Adhar has been awarded the Tata Citation of

Achievement for being the highest fundraising NGO in the Disability cause category at the Tata Mumbai Marathon 2023! Achieving such an award in a span of 4 years is a great achievement. We plan to make new records in the upcoming TMM 2024 for which work needs to start now. We need more corporates to participate, and also more pledge pages should be created by parents. An excellent example of a parents pledge page is the one created for Karan Dutt by his parents. It helped raise about ₹ 1 lakh this year. Over the past 3 years including the COVID years, Karan Dutt's page has been able to raise almost ₹ 3.3 lakhs.

Over the last three years, Adhar has raised around 69 lacs through pledge pages. We are looking forward to more support for fundraising. We need more Corporate Donors as well as pledge pages created by parents. Let's work together to make TMM 2024 a even bigger success.







Inauguration of the "Solar Project" by the officials of BNP Paribas Bank & CERE on 06th Jan 2023




Gudi Padwa Celebration

They took a round of the campus, and interacted with our special residents. He expressed his happiness on the new additions like solar energy projects, Dairy project etc.


