Since its inception in 1994, Adhar has grown to become one of India's largest and most respected institutions for this purpose, operating three centers in Maharashtra- Badlapur, Nashik, and the newly inaugurated Satara branch, which opened on April 17, 2024.




Caring for 340 residents aged 18 to 82; Adhar offers not only a safe and nurturing environment but also fosters significant community impact by creating over 270 jobs in rural areas, including 84 for women. Additionally, Adhar supports two other institutions in Solapur and Jalgaon, aiding economically disadvantaged families. Each year, Adhar directly impacts around 2000 lives across 18 states in India.

Recognized for its excellence, Adhar was awarded the 'Best Institution in Service to the Disabled' by the Government of India in 2014, with the award presented by then-President Shri Pranab Mukherjee. Through its innovative approach and dedicated service, Adhar continues to be a leading force in enhancing the lives of individuals with intellectual disabilities and setting a benchmark in compassionate care.

Chairman's Message



Dear Adhar Parivar,

Greetings, and a Happy and Prosperous Financial Year 2025-26 to all of you!

I am pleased to inform you that our plan for the rebuilding and redevelopment of infrastructure facilities at Adhar Badlapur is progressing faster than anticipated. This success is made possible due to the trust shown in Adhar by BNPP Foundation, SBI Foundation, and Chellaram Foundation, who have each taken on the responsibility for supporting the construction costs of a dormitory.

Last year, we successfully completed the female dormitory, supported by BNPP Foundation. In the current financial year (2025-26), we are on track to complete two more dormitories—each supported by SBI Foundation and Chellaram Foundation.

We are deeply grateful to these foundations for helping us transform Adhar Badlapur with state-of-the-art facilities for our special residents who have called this place home for over 30 years.

I understand that this redevelopment is an emotional event for many of us, as it marks the demolition of the place that has served as home for our special friends for three decades. However, just like the redevelopment of residential societies around us, old structures are being replaced with new, beautiful buildings. I assure you that within the next year, we will have completely new facilities that are spacious, airy, and well-lit, creating a far more inviting environment for our special children. The ambiance of Adhar Badlapur will undergo a complete transformation.

Adhar has long been an institution dedicated to supporting the parents of adults with intellectual disabilities. In an effort to provide financial relief to these families, alongside the psychological and

lifelong care we offer, I am proud to announce that the Board of Trustees has kept the monthly fees at ₹17,000 for the third consecutive year, starting from FY 2023-24. Despite the rising operational expenses due to inflation and salary revisions, we have made the decision to maintain these fees. This was a significant financial risk for us as Trustees, but we are confident that, with the continued support of corporate partners, philanthropic donors, individuals and parents, we will be able to raise the necessary funds to sustain our efforts.

I am also pleased to share that our participation in TMM 2025, with the support of our corporate partners and well-wishers, has enabled us to meet our fundraising targets. I extend my heartfelt thanks to the organizers and our team for their dedicated and committed efforts in making this event a great success for the benefit of Adhar.

ADHAR invites Nominations for Madhavrao Gore Seva Gaurav Award 2025

To commemorate the birth centenary of **Shri Madhavrao Gore**, a pioneer in social service and advocacy for the **intellectually challenged**, Adhar proudly announces the **Madhavrao Gore Seva Gaurav Puraskar** a prestigious national award dedicated to honoring excellence in intellectual disability services.

Instituted in 2024, this annual award recognizes registered NGOs in India that demonstrate innovation, commitment, and impact in supporting individuals with **intellectual challenges**, It celebrates organizations that have not only implemented effective practices but have also made a lasting difference in improving lives.

The award includes a **Trophy**, a **Certificate of Honor**, a Cash Prize of **₹50,000**, and the opportunity to gain **national visibility** through Adhar's vast network. To be eligible, NGOs must be **registered in India** and should have a minimum of **seven years** of active service for people with **intellectual challenges** sector. They must showcase a proven track record of **sustainable** programs and positive outcomes. Organizations receiving substantial government funding or those awarded in the past five years are not eligible.

The nomination process will be conducted in two stages:

Stage 1: Initial Submission – Interested organizations must submit the Stage-1 Nomination Form, available on the Adhar website. Deadline for Stage 1 submission: **30th June 2025**

Stage 2: Detailed Submission – Shortlisted NGOs will be asked to provide in-depth documentation, including detailed organizational information, program reports, and evidence of impact. The detailed form will be shared with shortlisted applicants only.

All entries will be thoroughly reviewed by a distinguished jury comprising experts in social work, disability rights, and development. A field visit will also be conducted to assess the operations and impact of shortlisted organizations. The jury's decision will be final. The award will be presented at a formal ceremony in Mumbai, Maharashtra, on the 4th Sunday of November 2025..

ADHAR Nashik: Infrastructural Upgrades

This quarter, significant upgrades have been made at our Nashik Special Home, all thanks to the generous support of our donors. These improvements have been crucial in enhancing the living conditions of our residents by increasing water availability, ensuring reliable transportation for medical and other needs, and creating a more efficient and comfortable environment for everyone.

Key Upgrades during the quarter:

- Two multipurpose vehicle has been added at the centre, significantly improving our ability to conduct medical follow-ups and ensure smooth operations
- 50 dormitory beds with mattresses have been replaced with new ones , for ensuring comfort of our residents.
- 4 new water storage tanks of 30,000 litres capacity have been installed and existing well deepened by 28 ft for ensuring a steady and reliable supply of water for daily needs.
- A state-of-the-art grey water treatment and recycling automatic plant has been set up has enabled us to manage water more efficiently and promote sustainable practices within the facility.
- 3 single-phase inverters for solar power have replaced a 3 phase inverter to ensure better solar efficiency while reducing our environmental footprint.
