## About ADHAR

### ADHAR: Special Home For Specially Abled

Adhar is a pioneering non-profit organization committed to providing lifelong care for adults with intellectual disabilities. Since its inception in 1994, Adhar has grown to become one of India's largest and most respected institutions for this purpose, operating three centers in Maharashtra - Badlapur (since Jan 1994), Nashik (since June 2012) & Satara (since April 2024).

Caring for over 435 residents aged 18 to 82; Adhar offers not only a safe and nurturing environment but also fosters significant community impact by creating over 270 jobs in rural areas, including 84 for women. Besides the three centers, Adhar supports two other institutions in Solapur and Jalgaon, aiding economically disadvantaged families. Each year, Adhar directly impacts around 2000 lives across 18 states in India.

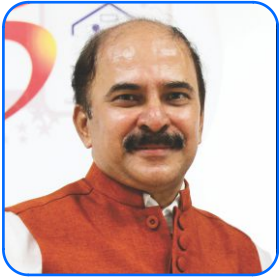

Through its innovative approach and dedicated service, Adhar continues to be a leading force in enhancing the lives of individuals with intellectual disabilities and setting a benchmark in compassionate care.

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## Chairman's Message



Dear Adhar Parivar,

As we step into the new financial year 2026-27, I extend my warm greetings and heartfelt gratitude to all our donors, partners, and well-wishers who have continued to support Adhar's journey.

I would like to share a few steps we have taken in our ongoing effort to support the care and well-being of special individuals and their families. We have recently started RESPITE HOME facility at all our centres to provide temporary care to specially abled individuals when parents or caregivers need a short break from continuous caregiving. We hope this initiative brings reassurance and some relief to families, knowing their loved ones is being cared for in a safe and supportive environment.

At our Satara centre, we have taken a step towards sustainability by installing a solar-powered system with support from BNP Paribas India. At the same time, understanding the socio-economic context of the region, we have reconsidered and reduced the maintenance fees to make our services more accessible to families from agriculture-based backgrounds, whose economic status is relatively lower than in other regions, so that more such special individuals can benefit.

Infrastructure development, along with ensuring quality care, continues to remain a priority. Our two new dormitories for male residents at Badlapur are nearing completion, and soon our 100 residents will move into these modern, well-equipped living spaces that will enhance their comfort and dignity.

While we regret that our esteemed trustee, Mr. K. S. Daryani, popularly known as 'Dadaji' in the Adhar Parivar, has stepped down from his role due to health reasons, we remain deeply grateful for his invaluable contribution to the institution since its

inception, which cannot be overstated or ignored. At the same time, we are delighted to welcome two new trustees who have joined us in our mission Mr. Amit Dutt and Mr. Anil Daryani, son of Mr. Daryani. They bring with them compassion and diverse, strong experience, and we are confident that their guidance will further strengthen our organisation's mission.

I am proud to share that Adhar once again participated in the Tata Mumbai Marathon 2026 for the seventh consecutive year. With the unwavering support of our donors and partners, we have been recognized as an Elite Level NGO- the highest privilege level and recognition an NGO can achieve at TMM-an achievement that belongs to all our supporters.

As we move forward, we remain committed to expanding our impact and continuing our mission of care, inclusion, and empowerment.

## ADHAR Welcoming our New Trustee's

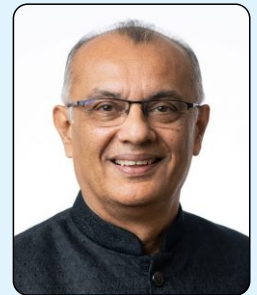


### Welcome Mr. Anil Daryani

As they say, life is a journey full of experiences, and we recently went through one ourselves. After retirement, when children move abroad, one often wishes to spend time with grandchildren, but situations change.

During this time, we visited 7–8 different places, gathered information, and finally found a safe and reliable place.

That place is truly a trusted home for senior citizens. Located in the scenic surroundings of Nashik district, this facility is run by the Association of Parents of Mentally Retarded Children, an organization doing remarkable social work.

Here, meals including tea, breakfast, and lunch are provided at very reasonable rates. We personally experienced the services and found the arrangements extremely satisfactory.

The residential facilities are well-maintained, clean, and comfortable. Each resident is provided

with a separate, neat room with proper hygiene standards.

Facilities include bed tea, blankets, a small fridge, TV, AC, and 24-hour hot water. In addition, there is CCTV security, police verification, and regular provision of tea, coffee, and other refreshments.

For relaxation and recreation, there is a small garden, seating areas, and spaces where residents can interact freely and spend quality time together.

The entire arrangement is highly satisfactory, with 24-hour support available. We stayed here for a month and experienced the warmth, care, and personal attention provided by the staff.

We truly feel that senior citizens can live here comfortably and securely. Having personally experienced this place, we can say it is a trustworthy and caring environment.

We extend our best wishes to everyone who chooses to begin a new phase of life here.

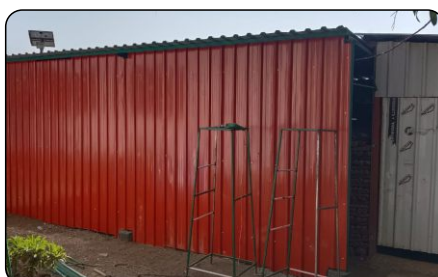
## ADHAR Nashik: Infrastructural Upgrades

At Adhar Satara, a fully equipped Special Care Centre has been set up with the generous support of **Fine Organic Industries Ltd**.

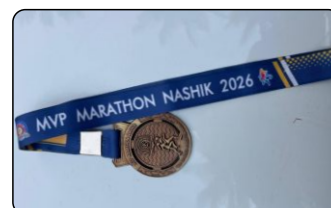
The initiative also includes an ambulance facility, ensuring timely medical support and enhanced care for our special friends, strengthening the centre's overall healthcare infrastructure.
